Job Description – Volunteer EAP Peer Coordinator

- The Peer Coordinator advocates for the use of the Members Assistance Program by providing information to employees, their families, union representatives; and management as requested by the member. The Peer Coordinator also communicates regularly with the appropriate Regional Coordinator.
- The Peer Coordinator provides support and encourages the employee to accept and follow through on Members Assistance Program/EAP recommendations.
- The Peer Coordinator must understand the importance of confidentiality.
- The Peer Coordinator will support the employee in the return to work process.
- A basic understanding of employee benefits is required.
